

Role Outline: Welfare Officer

The Welfare Officer's role is to promote the club/organisation's policy and procedures for the protection of children and vulnerable adults.

Main Duties Skills Required (NB If you club has a sport specific Child Protection Policy, these duties should be revised to be in line with it) The distribution/display of Approachable and friendly leaflets/codes of conduct to Good listener/effective communicator members, parents and young people Confident, with good leadership skills Advise on the development of Great organisational skills activities for young people within the Enthusiastic and a good motivator club/organisation Knowledge of child protection policies Support the registration of all and procedures and Criminal personnel involved in activities for Records checks young people within the club/organisation (CRB checks) Knowledge of the Data Protection Act Receive, record and pass on to the Ability to deal with confidential NGB Child Protection Officer, any matters concerns relating to the welfare of Tactful when dealing with sensitive young people and vulnerable adults issues Attend committee meetings.

Meetings are held at a location suitable for the committee. The AGM is held in April each year. The term of office is 1 year starting 30th April. You need to have your own IT equipment.
